Death comes to us all, no matter how many vitamins we take or how carefully we guard our health. Few people like to think about it seriously. Many people fear to make a will in case it precipitates the event itself. Everyone fears it in one way or another. Those who say they do not are fooling themselves. It is the last, and the greatest mystery.

If we cannot avoid it, we can prepare for it. The Initiate uses a Death Working that helps them to pass over, either in full consciousness, or at least

prepared for the transition. We all know, if we read a particularly exciting or interesting book just before we sleep, we may find ourselves dreaming about the contents of the book. A Death Working takes that idea a step further. The Initiate deliberately builds a situation/location that is programmed the begin working as the body shuts down.

In this workshop there are techniques for assisting at Death-beds, easing the way for those entering the final stages and advice for those suffering a terminal illness, and their families. The death of children and young people is one of the most distressing and there is advice to help those in this situation.

Finally, though we prefer not to think about it, there is much that can be done for those who have met with a violent death, even after death has occurred.
